ST. PAUL'S CHURCH HEATING SEATON LIBRARY APPEAL

Over the years, we have had significant issues in the boiler house with flooding at St Paul's and each time there has been a flood further damage has been a caused to the boiler. The boiler, which is at least 35 years old and not as efficient as it should be, is now in need of replacing. The Parochial Church Council has submitted an application to the Diocese of Carlisle for this work to be done. The estimated costs of the work in total is £22, 000, and although we have some funds that we can use we still need to raise between £6,000 and £9,000 to reach the target. Currently, we have raised £5,712 through donations. The crowdfunding page raised £1,195 and we would like to thank all who contributed through this. We will be looking to hopefully bolster the funds through our Annual Gift Day.

ANNUAL GIFT DAY

For a number of years, we have been holding an Annual Gift Day issued Gift have Day envelopes with the May edition of The Villager. This year, we will do so again on Sunday 28th May. Over the years the extra financial support received through the Gift Day has enabled us to carry out various projects in and around out buildings and we are always grateful for the generosity of members of the community. This year, as you are aware, together with increased running costs for our two churches and the church hall, we are also raising funds to replace the boiler in St. Paul's Church and some of the Gift Day donations will go towards this. We hope that people will continue to support our churches as we go forward, enabling us to continue to be a central part of the life of community, serving people of Seaton and Camerton and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with you. Envelopes can be returned to the church on that day in person or via church members. They can also be passed to Rev Ian at The Vicarage.
