## Longing for light....

A few days ago, I decided to move my office around a bit, something I used to do quite often but haven't done for a while now, with the hope of achieving two objectives. Firstly, to create a little more room and secondly, by turning my desk around to have a little more from the window in front of me and the room light behind me. The first one worked well, but the second one hasn't been quite as effective yet, mainly since with the weather we have had over the last few days there hasn't been much light coming in through the window. To be fair there hasn't been much light at all, and I find myself longing for those winter days when it's cold, but not windy or raining, with clear blue skies and a bit of weak winter sun filtering in.

Thinking of long periods of darkness during the day time brought to me the fact that we are about to enter December and I need to give myself a shake because that's what it's like at this time of year, and at the same time we are entering into Advent - the season that reminds us that Christmas is coming (not that we really need any reminding as shops are full, decorations are going up, and almost every other E mail I seems to mention receive the 'countdown to Christmas').

For churches Advent is a time to prepare, to get ready, and often you will find that during this time that church buildings can be bare and almost stark, dark places – very different to what we are used to at other times of the year. Of course, all of this will change, and they will look and feel very different, thanks to a lot of hard work from a number of people, as we eventually reach Christmas.

Away from the church side of things this time of year is also a dark time quite literally, now that the clocks have gone back, with dark mornings and it being dark again mid to late afternoon. For some people this can have the effect of making them lonely and fearful and they long for the darkness of winter to be over.

But, as we journey through Advent, and the month of December in particular, I always find, when out and about, that despite the darkness around us, whether that be where we live or at the moment with the things we see and hear in the news around the world and at home, light begins to gradually take over again, as we see houses being decorated, lights on trees and in gardens, Christmas trees adorning windows and curtains open so they can be seen. Gradually the darkness is replaced by light and spirits start to lift again.

This reminds me of why we celebrate Christmas and the Birth of Jesus, born in a cold, dark, stark place, in a trouble world, to bring joy, and hope and LIGHT. In the bible we read, in St John's gospel, 'the light shines in the darkness and the darkness did not overcome it'- – reference to Jesus as the LIGHT of the World, whose birth we celebrate - The LIGHT of the World represented by the candle that will sit in the centre of oranges that will be given out at our Christingle services on Christmas Eve, the Jesus whom the Magi found after being led by the LIGHT of a bright star.

As we journey through Advent and December my hope and prayer is that everyone will take time to experience the change from darkness to LIGHT and will be ready to enjoy the Christmas season in its fulness.

As I often do, I'd like to close with some words from a hymn, or in this case a modern worship song and one of my favourites called, **Longing for Light** 

Longing for light, we wait in darkness, longing for truth we turn to you,

Make us your own, your holy people, Light for the world to see.

Christ be our Light shine in our hearts, shine through the darkness.

Christ be our light, shine in your Church gathered today.

With my very best wishes for a Happy and Peaceful Christmas and may the Light ad Peace of the Christ child be with you.
