Hopefully this has stayed with us into adulthood and I would like to use this months front page article to share some excerpts from a letter of thanks sent out recently to all those who give regularly to support the life and work of our churches in Seaton and Camerton. I am conscious that there are many people who give in other ways and it different times of the year and feel it important that they are thanked as well.

*In 2023, thanks to your kindness and generosity we were able to:* 

- ☐ Pay our Ministry Offer in full (£40,000), contributing to the costs of mission and ministry (clergy) in our parish, mission community and diocese.
- ☐ Install new heating boilers and associated works (£21000+), with the help of additional fundraising and grants meaning we no

longer face the issue of a lack of heating due to the boiler house at St Paul's flooding

- ☐ Continue to support local groups and organisations.
- ☐ Maintain our buildings and grounds to a high standard
- ☐ Meet all our other financial commitments (insurance, utilities, etc).

Looking ahead we face an increase in our Ministry Offer (£41600) which contributes towards the cost of our clergy, clergy housing and the training of future clergy, and a significant increase in the cost of utilities. Achieving this takes time, effort and of course money, and it would not be possible without the generous support from our regular church members and members of the community – such generosity really does make a difference and on behalf of myself and the Parochial Church Council I would like to offer sincere thanks to everyone.

Of course, not everyone gives and not everyone makes use of our churches, but at the same time we all want them to be here, both now and in the future, providing a centre for regular worship, as well as those all important family celebrations, both happy and sad. To continue to do so we need your help and support.
