We have been able to change the school phonics curriculum, provide new opportunities such as Forest Schools, outdoor learning, residentials, Bingo nights as well as revamped Christmas and Summer Fairs. The school staff has a sense of ownership over the change and fully embraced the opportunity to Academy make Seaton а wonderful and inviting school. I have been honoured, to be a part of this journey, and we are just at the beginning.

What's clear is that I could not have done this alone. This required a team. This was farreaching; from the kitchen staff preparing late into the night, cleaners ensuring the the classrooms are clean and fit for purpose, the caretaker painting the school day after day, the busy admin's office, the tireless work of support staff and teachers, notwithstanding the immense contribution of the Trustees. The role of each of these members is completely different, but all are equally valued because they are what makes the 'Seaton Academy Team!' 'We' are the ones who make it work.

In School, we emphasise the importance of teamwork through lessons. assemblies and sports opportunities. I am incredibly proud to lead the Seaton Academy team - we are all members, with different contributions, which makes School work on a day-to-day basis. Every team needs unity. A team has to move as one unit, one force, with each person assisting the roles of his teammates. Seaton Academy

has that. Teams take many forms, this could be a family unit, a local community group or perhaps a sporting club. We should be proud of the teams we are in, as our contribution is truly valued. As we moved forward into the next academic year we know there will be new opportunities and even some new challenges. We look forward to embracing those opportunities and challenges as a strong team.
